

RESPONSIBLE ADULT IN CHILD CARE SETTINGS COURSE

Self-Paced Online Sessions

- Open a Licensed Family Child Care or Registered License Not Required (RLNR) Child Care*

This course, developed by Westcoast Child Care Resource Centre, meets the 20 hour training requirements to qualify individuals as Responsible Adults to work in child care settings with children from birth to 12 years of age.

*If planning to open a family child care program, participants completing this course can also take the 16 hour Administration for Family Child Care (AFCC) course.

Cost: \$100 per participant. Includes online workbook access. Participants must be 19 years old to register and attend all sessions to receive a certificate of completion.
